



BECOME A YES VOLUNTEER

Thank you for your interest in becoming a YES Program volunteer!

Volunteers are needed to assist with the following:

- Greeting participants and parents upon arrival
- Assist with check-in the day of sessions
- Monitor halls and transitions from session and restrooms
- Assist with tutoring and homework
- Assist meal service
- Man the Harmony CDC table and assist with information sharing for upcoming trainings and programs

What is the time commitment?

You can sign up to assist weekly for 1 to 3 hours. While we would love for you spend the entire program with us, you do not have to commit to the full 6 weeks.

How many volunteers do we need?

Volunteer need: 10-15; Mentor need: 25-45 to support group mentoring initiatives.

It is important that we are thoughtful, concerning selecting those who are allowed the privilege to serve our youth. Interactions with them and their families could potentially have a profound effect on the child's life. Due to this, our volunteer intake process is robust.

We want our volunteers to be as ready and equipped as possible.

To Become a YES Volunteer, You Must Meet the Following Criteria:

- Be at least 21 years old
- No violent or drug and alcohol charges for minimum of 5 years
- No violent crimes against children
- Approved via background check to work with youth
- Previous experience working with youth ages 13-18 years is desirable

Steps To Become A YES Volunteer

STEP 1: Attend a Harmony CDC YES Program information session.

We will share information about our mission, vision, history, expectations and answer frequently asked questions.

STEP 2: Complete volunteer application, review and sign our child safety policies & procedures and child abuse policy.

STEP 3: Complete MinistrySafe training.

Harmony CDC will email you a link to a one hour sexual abuse training video after completing your application. Immediately following the video, complete the simple online quiz.

STEP 4: Background check and references.

Harmony CDC will conduct a background check and reach out to your references. Please inform them that they will be receiving an email from Harmony CDC.

STEP 5: Complete YES Program Volunteer Training

STEP 6: Confirm your Volunteer Commitments and begin serving!
